

## OUTLINE OF EVENTS IN CHICAGO AND ROME

Day 3 - Day 7  
April 3 – 8, 2005

### DAY 3 (April 4, 2005)

- **7 p.m.** Prayer Service with priests, deacons, religious, and lay ecclesial movements at HNC with Vicar General George Rassas.

### DAY 4 (April 5, 2005)

- **7 p.m.** Ecumenical/Interreligious Service at HNC in the evening. Consular corps and Civic leaders are invited. Service will include writings of Pope John Paul II.

### DAY 7 (April 8, 2005)

- This will be the day of the papal funeral.
- Catholic schools will be open. School children may watch rebroadcast or tape of funeral, depending on technological capabilities of individual schools.
- Archdiocesan Offices will remain open.
- Holy Name Cathedral and all churches will toll their bells for five minutes beginning at noon. Bells should be placed on the funeral setting.
- There will be a Mass at Holy Name Cathedral. The Mass will take place at 5:15 p.m. Each pastor is asked to send two representatives to the Mass. Bishop Goedert will preside.
