The Cardinal Carmerlengo and the cardinals who formerly held the offices of Secretary of State and Pres. of the Pontifical Commission for Vatican City State are charged with arranging lodging for the cardinal electors.+

The Dean of the College of Cardinals presides at the General Congregations.

The Cardinal Vicar for Rome informs the people of the death of the Pope.

The Cardinal Archpriest takes possession of the apostolic palace, and the palaces of the Lateran and Castel Gandolfo.

A delegate of the Carmerlengo in the presence of members of the Apostolic Camera draws up documents certifying that burial has taken place. A delegate of the Prefect of the Papal Household in the presence of the Prefect of the Papal Household does the same.
